Qualifications:

Applicants must be 16 years old before the first day of the camp they are applying for (I.e. If an applicant turns 16 on July 24th, they may apply for any camp beginning July 25th or thereafter)

No other previous qualifications are necessary, though the following are considered assets: previous experience working with children in an outdoor setting, previous leadership experience, a basic first aid certification (8hr), rock-climbing certifications (ex: ACMG, belay ticket), flatwater canoe certifications, Class 4 Driver's License, and other relevant childcare and outdoor education certifications

Note: Two valid references and a clear criminal record check will be required
